Available Data:

- OECD - [foreign born population](#) for selected countries based on census data around the year 2000
- EUROSTAT Population Data - [foreign nationals and foreign born population](#) data for all countries but only for some countries differentiated by age-groups
- EUROSTAT Labour Force Survey - [foreign born population](#) for 26 EU-countries (without Ireland)

Labour Force Survey

Target population: persons - 15 years or older - in private households

Sample size: the sampling rates vary between 0.2% and 3.3%

Availability: annually

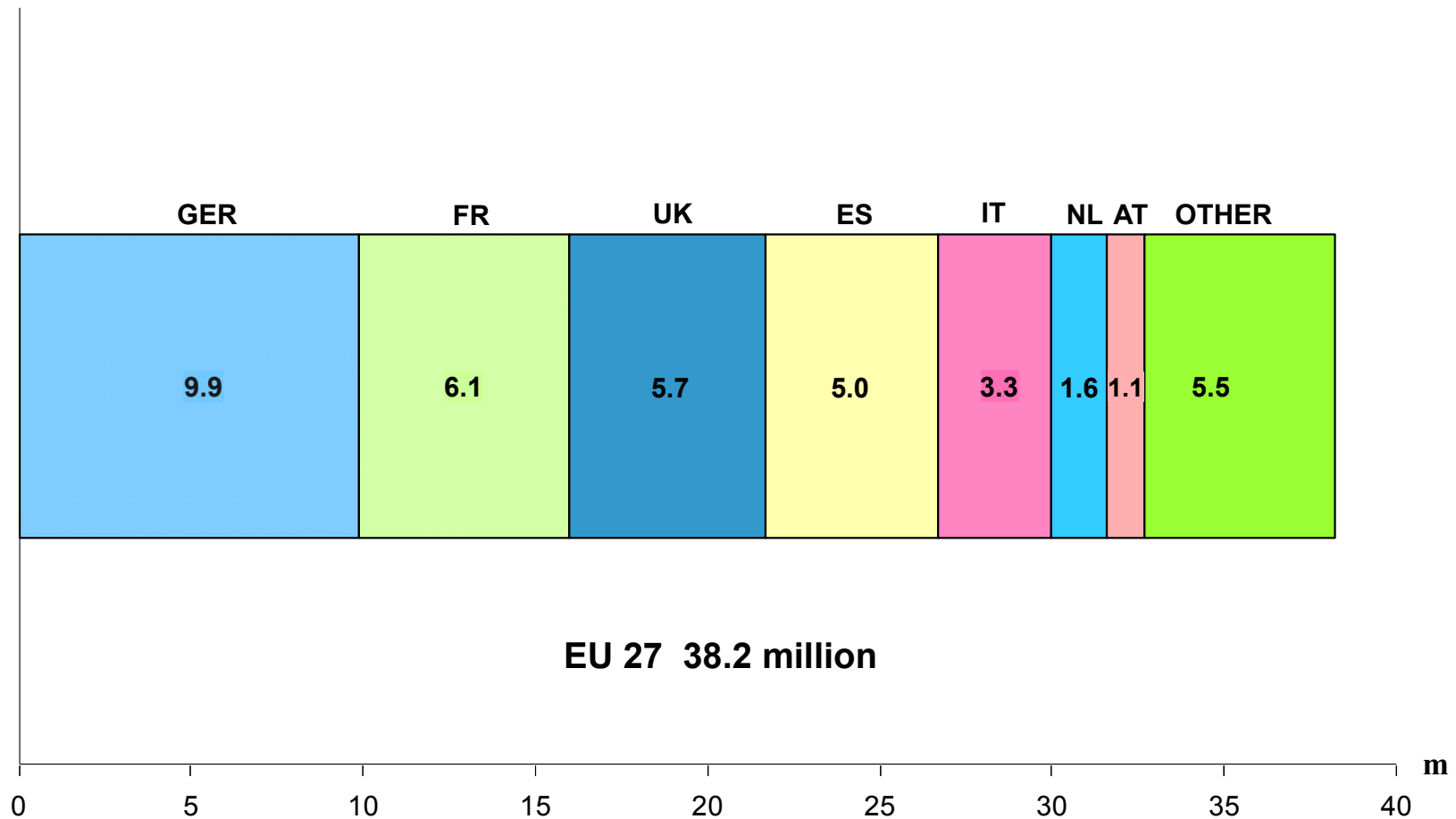
Main Topic: Labour market

- national modules

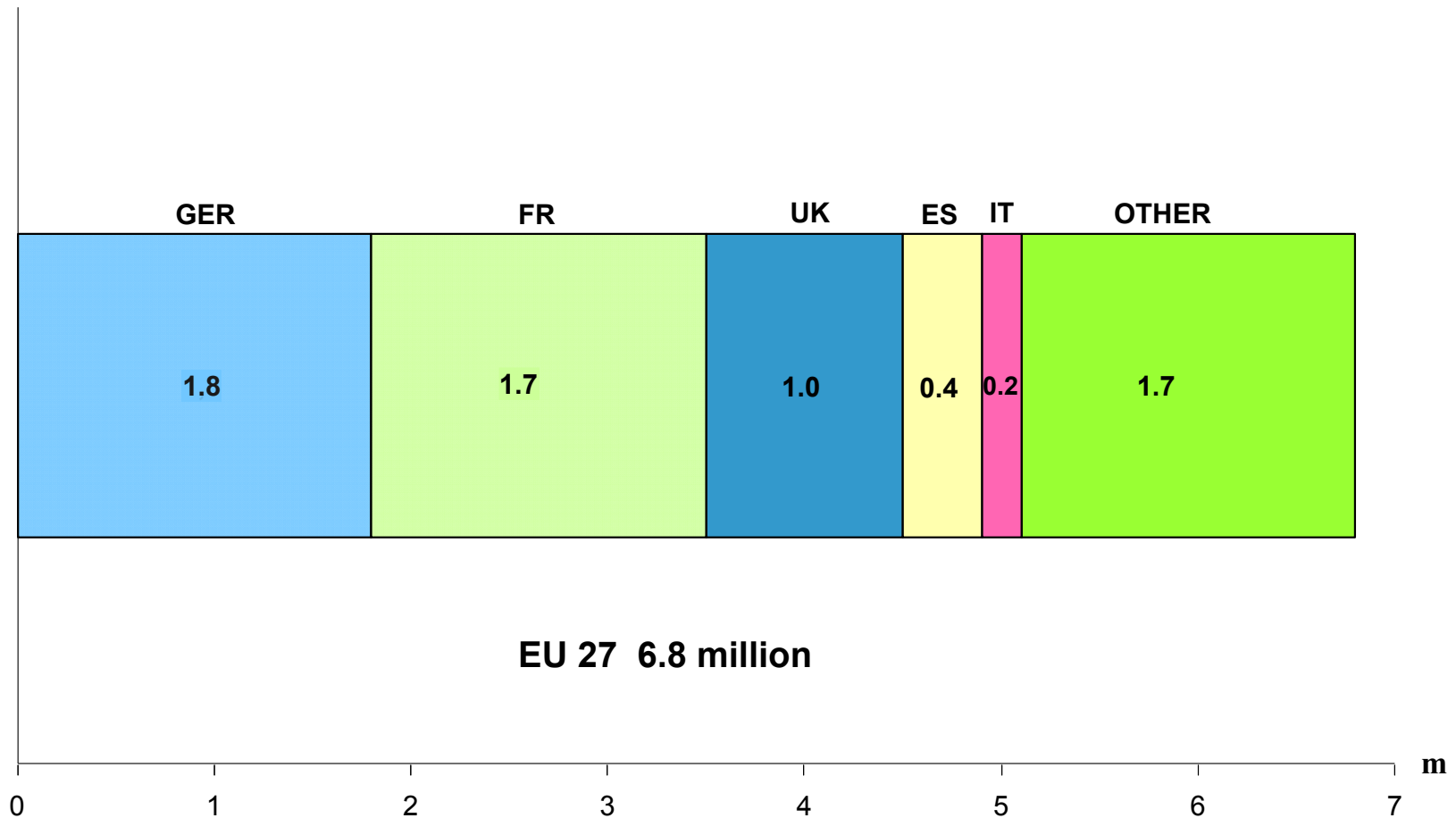

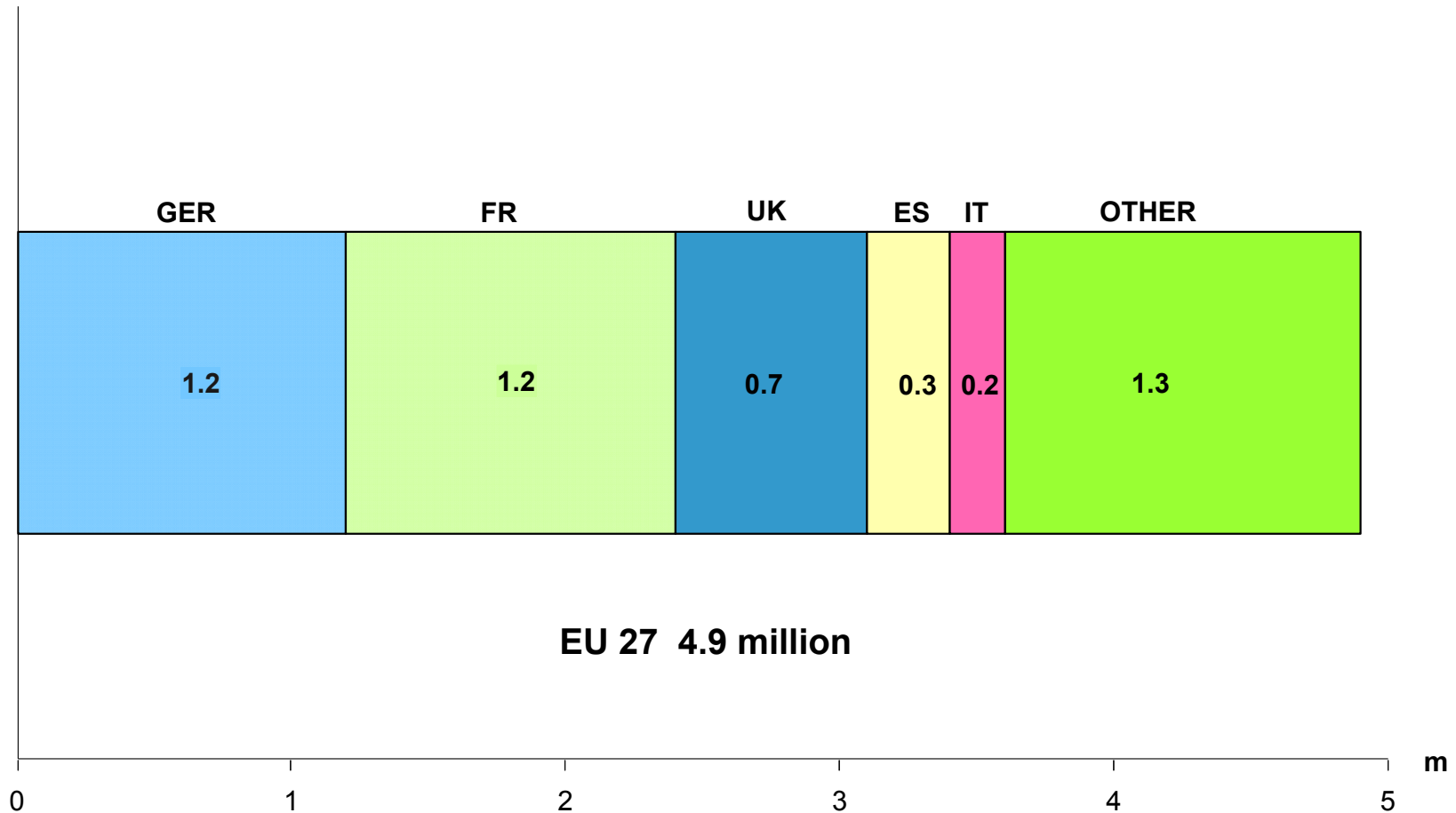
Migrant population

60 years and older

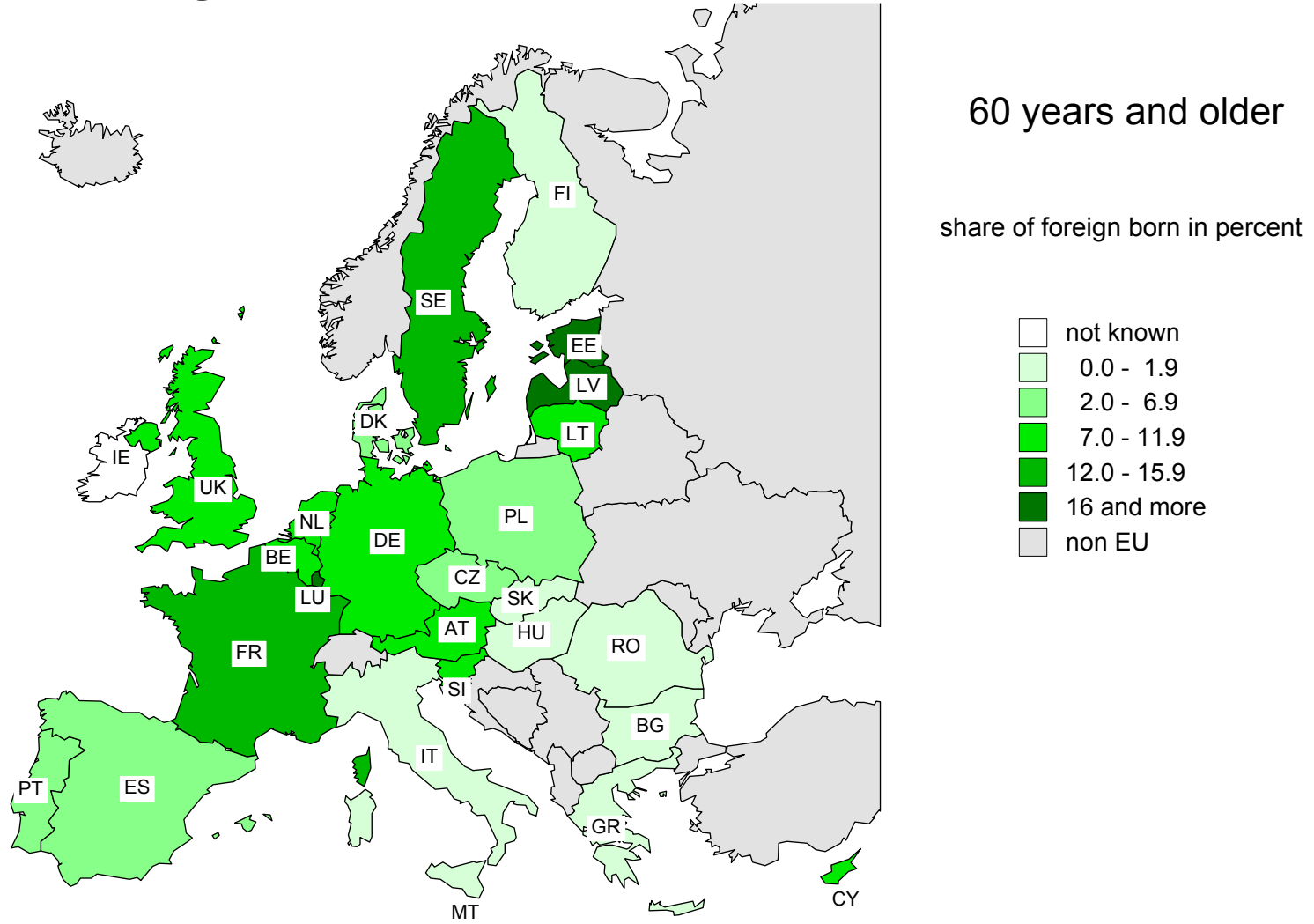

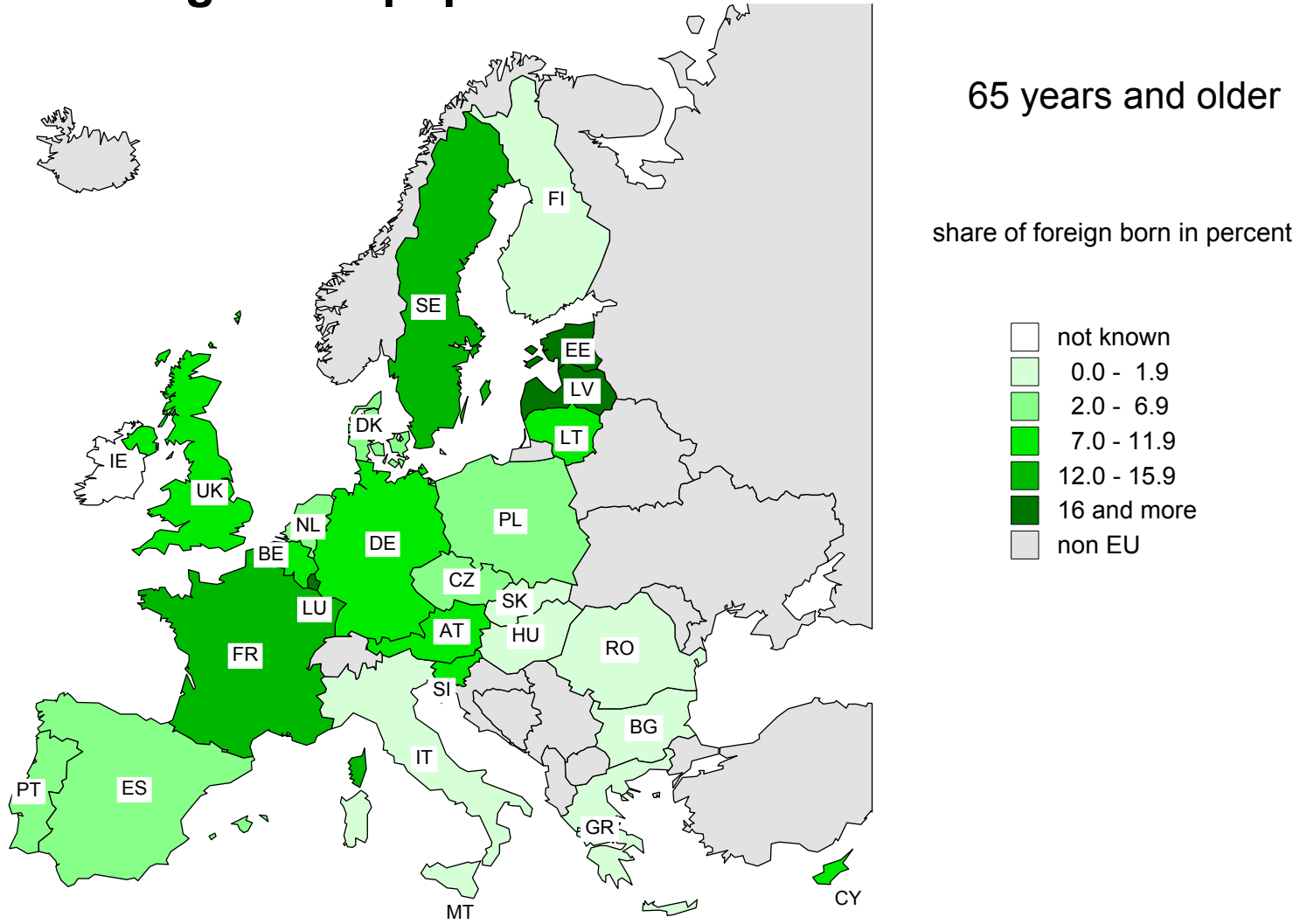

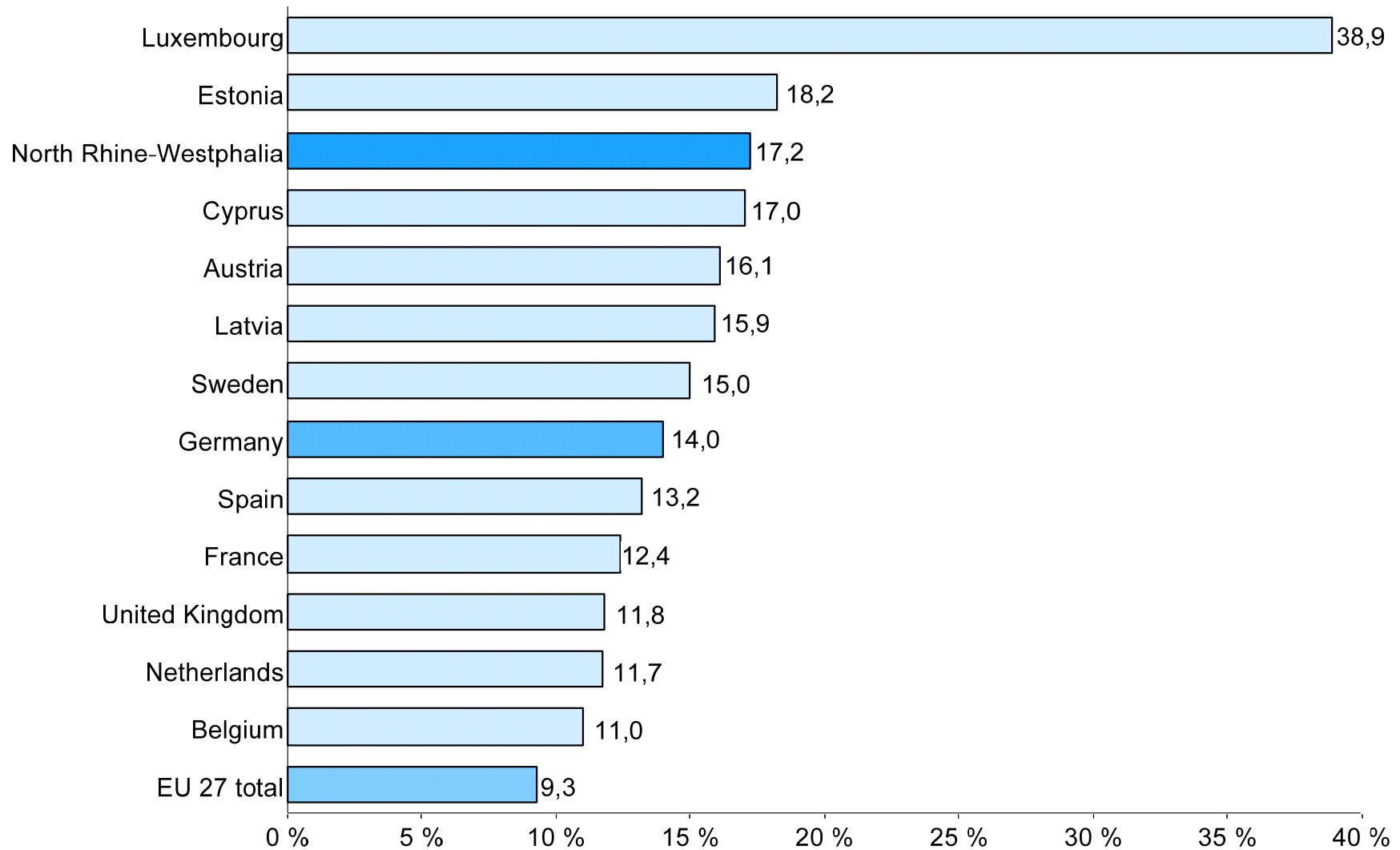

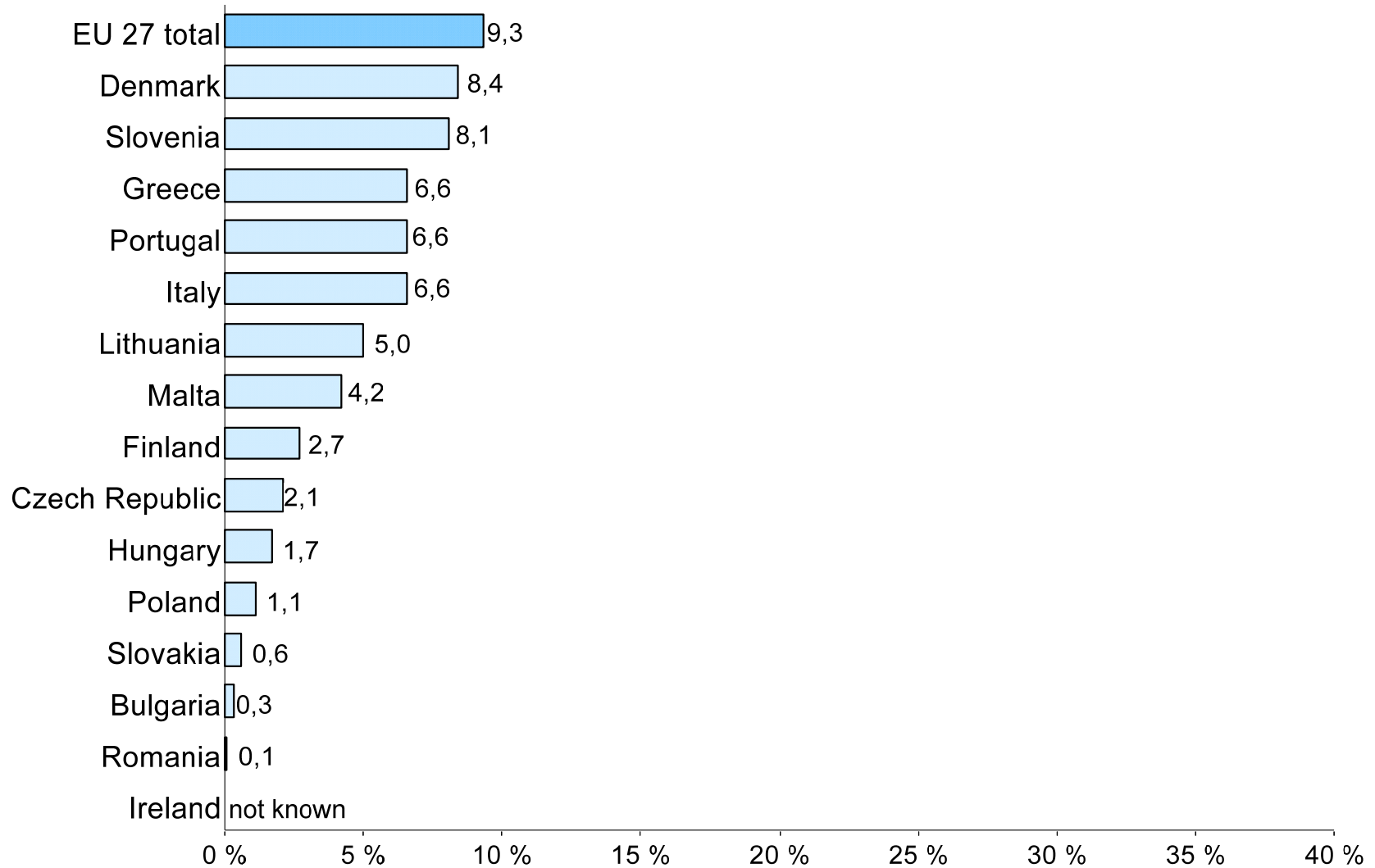

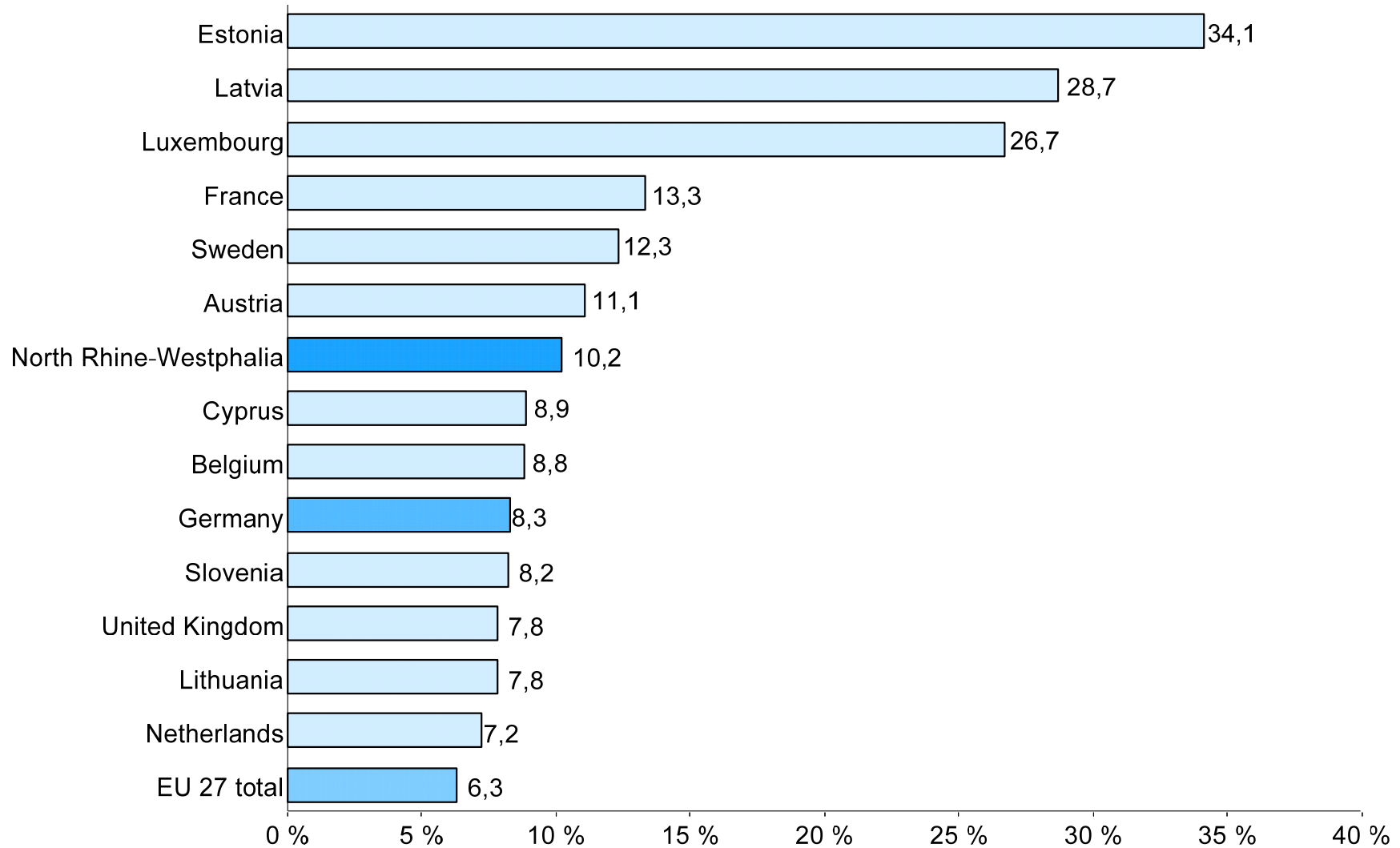

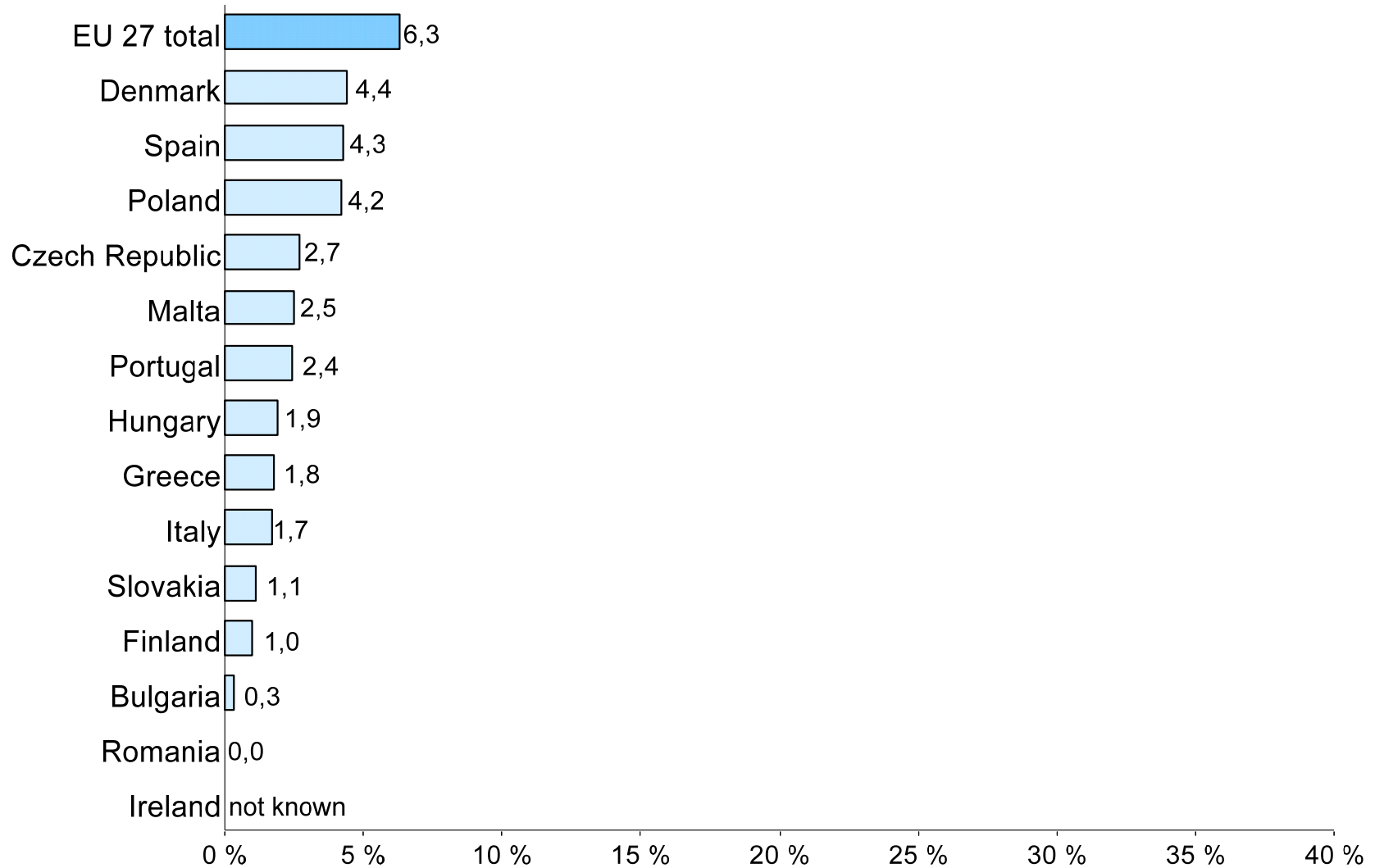

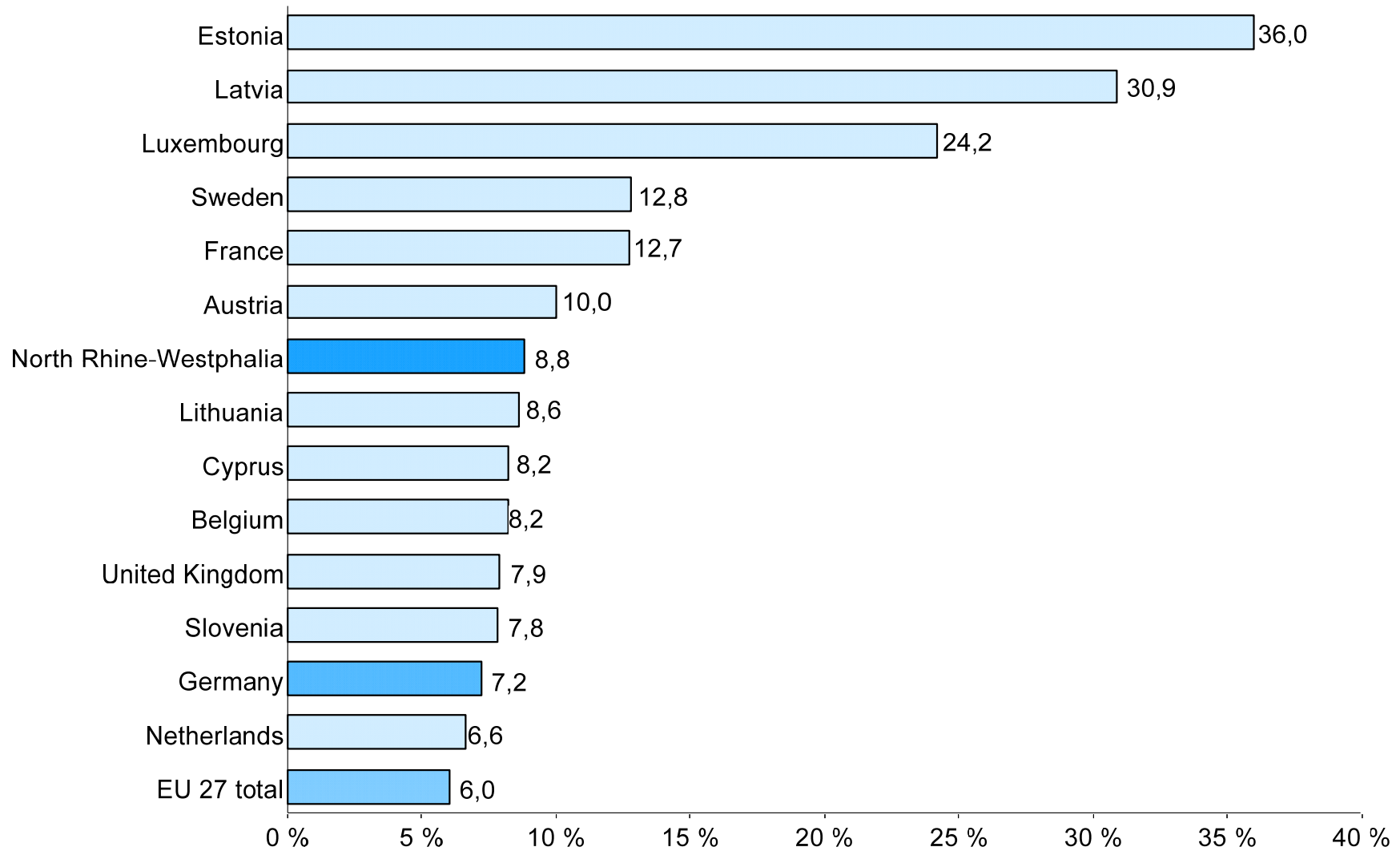

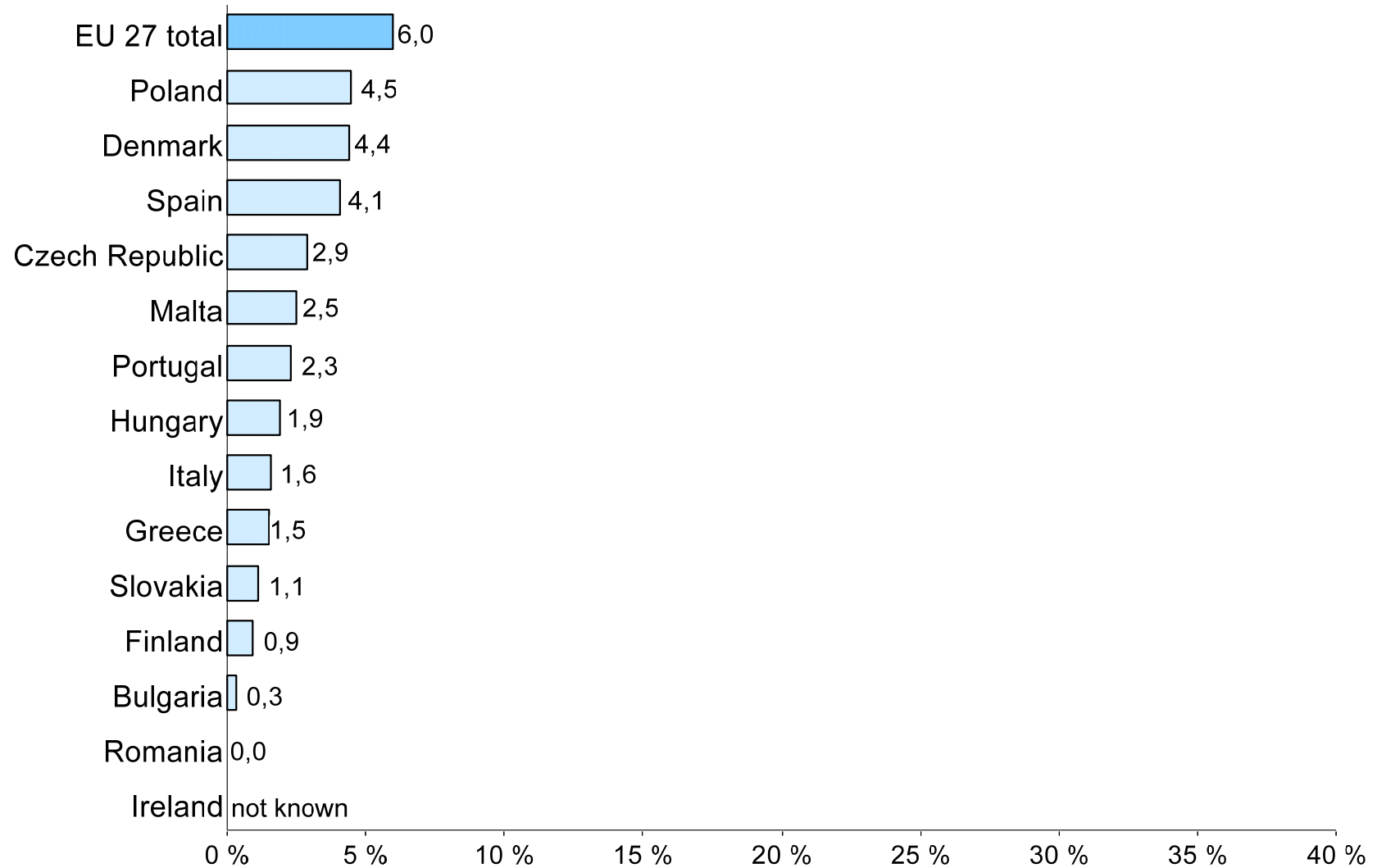

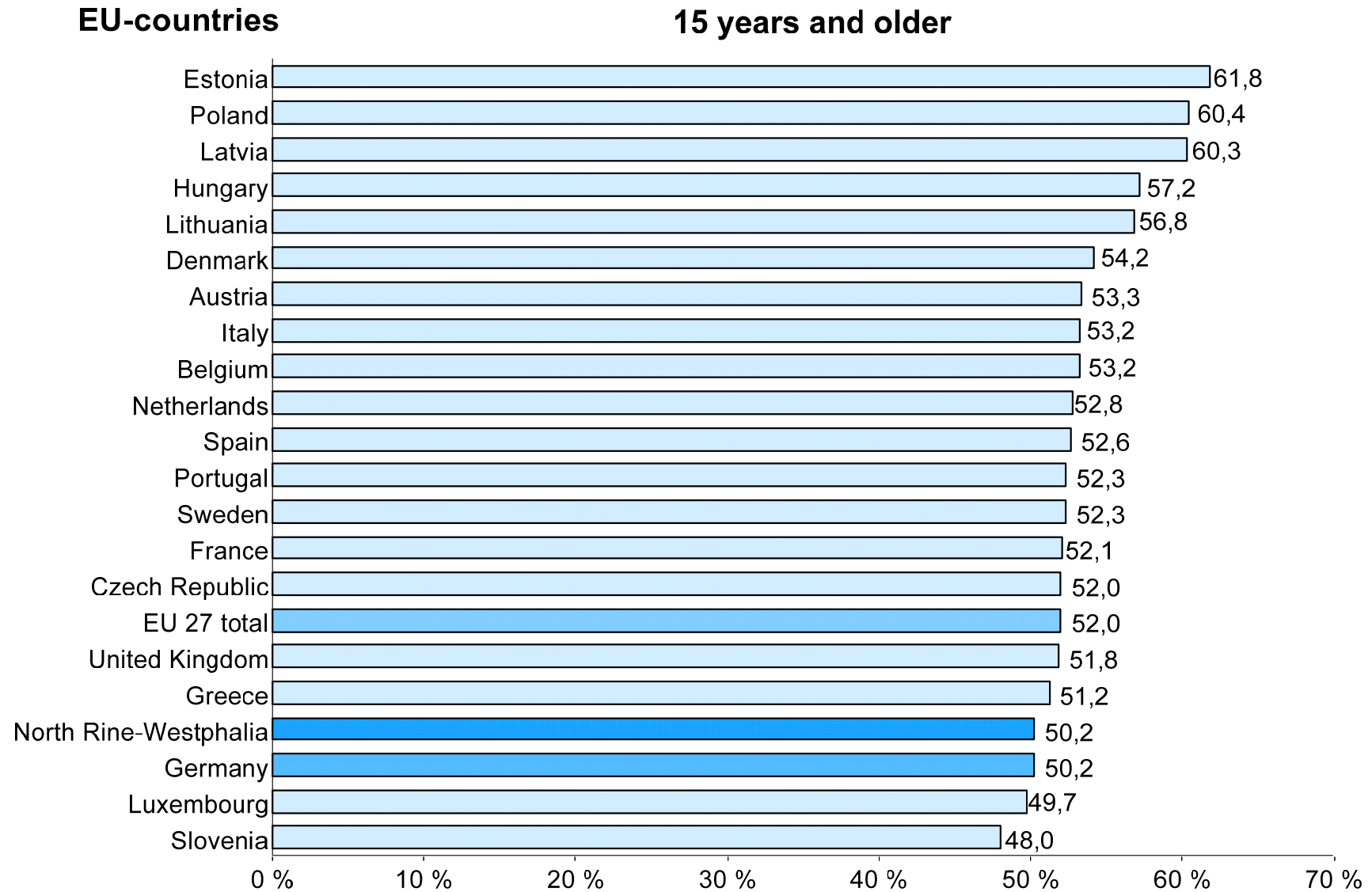

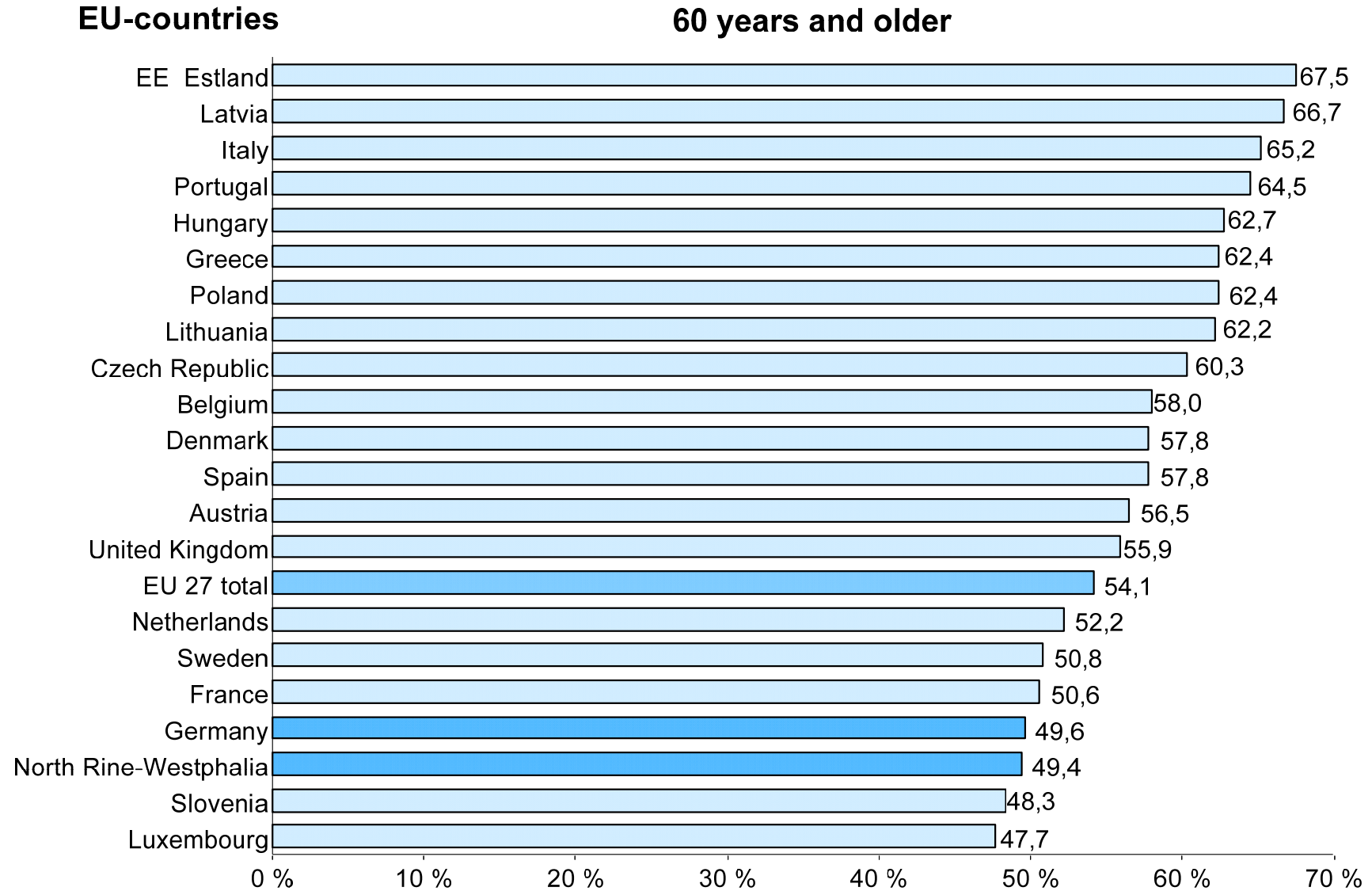

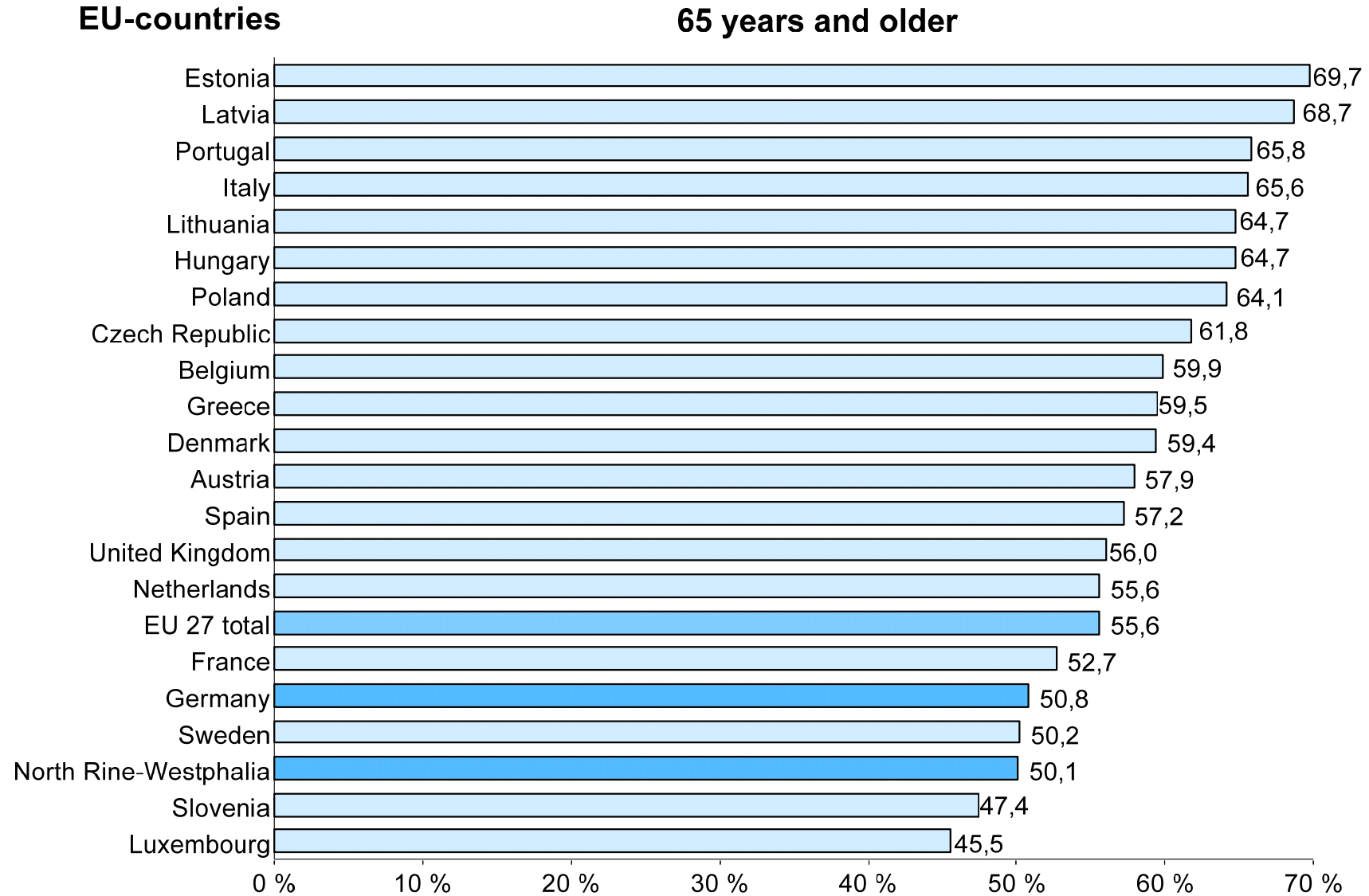
Share of foreign born females in 2007
